

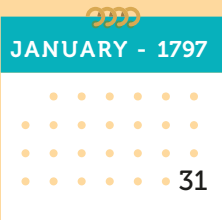

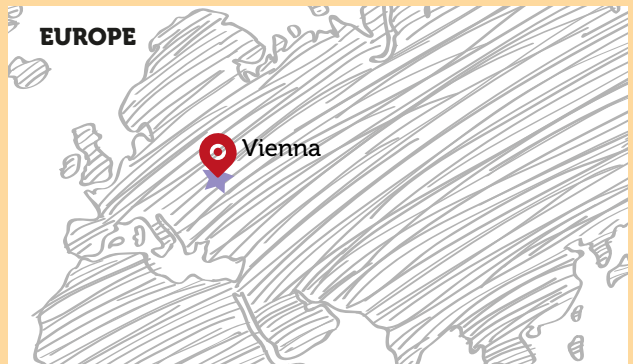

This is the way we called my meetings with friends, where we told stories, sang and danced the music I composed.



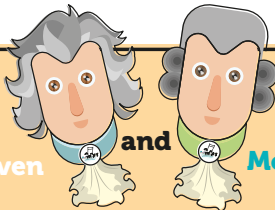
Just like Mozart, melodies would come out of my head. As soon as I was done with a song, I would start another one. All my melodies are easy to sing and catchy. **Can you sing the melody of my Serenade? Make up a song and have fun.**

I wrote small musical pieces called Impromptus and musical moments, 9 symphonies and made up more than 600 new song types: The Lied, a singable melody with piano and a poetic text that came out during the romanticism like the Hail Mary.
